Assists individuals in meeting their physical needs, including feeding, bathing, dressing, grooming, personal hygiene and toileting. Increases the individual's independence by assisting with activities of daily living that build on the individual's strengths and capabilities. Provides skills training when needed.

Successful Restorative Program - PHCA

Dressing and/or grooming: Code activities provided to improve or maintain the resident's self-performance in dressing and

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undressing, bathing and washing, and performing other personal hygiene tasks. These activities are individualized to the resident's needs, planned, monitored, evaluated, and documented in the resident's medical record. 8.
